




HEAD ROAD CAPTAIN

rides 42. Average number of riders per ride is 12. The average trip miles destination only is 77 and average round trip miles per ride is 119. Lastly the total miles for all riders is 58,450.






MEMBERSHIP & GOODWILL

SAFETY OFFICER'S MESSAGE



Best Practices for Lining Up For rides

The following paragraphs come courtesy of Paul Callahan, who is Safety Officer for his H.O.G. chapter in Milwaukee as well as a Rockstar Road Captain:

Believe it or not, there is an art and science to lining up for our rides. Here are some tips to make things easier and safer for everyone on our group rides:


- 1) Please pull up to the front of the group with no gaps. You should be within a foot or so of the bike in front of you. Leaving gaps make is difficult to keep bikes in order and confuses people when leaving for the ride as to who goes next.
- 2) Please line up in two columns, not haphazardly parked 3 or 4 across. This avoids all the side-to-side adjustments as we depart and people try to get into a proper staggered formation.
- 3) Please park all trikes in the left column. This sets the group up to avoid having two trikes next to each other. We have been told by some trike riders that the left column is easier to ride in and less rough.

- 4) Please make sure you check in with the Lead Road Captain or the Sweep using your VIB number. Remember, every ride gets you points which are worth \$\$ at Rockstar.
- 5) If you have a passenger who is not a member of Rockstar H.O.G., they must sign a waiver on every ride. NO exceptions for non-members. Road Captains carry these forms.

Following these simple guidelines makes our ride line up and departure much easier and safer.

Thanks, Paul. Also, I wanted to let Chapter riders know that the Collier County Sheriff's Motor Unit is again offering free S.M.A.R.T. classes on these upcoming dates: 4/15-4/16; 4/29-4/30; and 5/20-5/21.
