## SECRETARY'S REPORT



#### **February 2022 Board Meeting**

The regular meeting of the Rockstar H.O.G. Chapter Board of Directors was called to order at 5:50 PM on February 7, 2022 by Bob. The meeting was held at Cantina Laredo in Fort Myers.

Strategic Planning Committee Update: Susan McDonald resigned from the committee and a search is underway to replace her. Scott Sheppard submitted a list of suggestions which were discussed. Fred said they would be discussed at the Road Captains' meeting. Bob volunteered to ask the Dealer if VIB points could be awarded for Wednesday rides.

Regional Officer Connection takeaways: Brenda said: All chapters struggle with the same issues of attracting and retaining members. Membership/Renewal form is a legal document that must be signed and dated in the year it covers. Janice: It was interesting that many chapters had had a dealership close and a merging of chapters. She said it was much more common than she expected. And she thought it was interesting that ROC emphasized the dealer owns the chapter. Steve M. was disappointed that no bullet points were given as to how to actually retain members. Fred said it was interesting that there is no consistency between chapters when it comes to signing in members for meetings and events. Bob said the importance of no alterations to H.O.G. forms is emphasized since they are legal documents. He also mentioned that anyone, not just Road Captains, may lead a chapter ride.

Holiday Party updates: Anne and Brenda are co-chairs. We have a contract for Dec. 10 at the Holiday Inn in Fort

Myers. Tickets are \$25 and there will be beef, chicken, fish and vegan options. Hors d'oeuvres will be passed. Two drink tickets per attendee and after that it is a cash bar. Tickets are for alcohol or soft drinks. Fred moved and Steve E. seconded that we sign the contract. All voted in favor.



Gary, our quartermaster, reported that shirt pricing will be the same as last year. He presented suggestions for what we should buy, which was 24 men's T-shirts in various colors and sizes and 24 women's T-shirts in various colors and sizes and 10 bike flags. Bob moved and Anne seconded to buy what Gary suggested. Eight voted in favor with one opposed. Then caps were discussed. The fitted, tonal model was chosen and it is a minimum order of 12, which we will do on a prepaid basis. Fred moved and Anne seconded that we should proceed with this.

Membership. We have 193 paid 2022 members and seven with no national H.O.G. numbers or who did not pay. We agreed that people must pay by Feb. 28 and Anne will purge the rolls on March 1.

Easter Bunny Toy Run at Golisano Children's Hospital: Bob is waiting to hear from the hospital if it is a go this year.

Treasurer's Report: The Chapter is in sound financial condition.






## HEAD ROAD CAPTAIN

## SAFETY OFFICER'S MESSAGE




#### When Riding Always Be Prepared for Rain

Although our weather is wonderful at this time of year it's not too early to plan ahead for our raining season. As I mentioned at the last chapter meeting, it's a good idea to purchase and have on hand one of the products used to help bead water on our shields, visors, or glasses. These products apply beading technology and will dramatically enhance visibility during rain. Remember if using Rain X, it comes in the plastic compatible form.

Always, clean the plastic really well, with something that doesn't deposit anything on it. Then rub this on with a synthetic cloth (like the microfiber dust cloths, quickie et al), and just keep rubbing until it is evenly foggy. Then take a dry spot of the cloth and rub until it's clear again. Instructions explicitly tell you not to use paper towels.

Although we can't endorse any one product, some of our members have had good experience using some of these commercially available products such as:

Rain X "Plastic" Water Repellent



Top Coat F11\* (it is entirely safe

to use the F11 on all the components, even plastic)

BugSlide Spray (Leaves a protective, microscopic finish that continually repels dust, dirt, water & fingerprints)

All Kleer Windshield Cleaner & Polish


